The European Federation of Chemical Engineering (EFCE) is pleased to announce the

### **EFCE Student Mobility Award 2009.**

The objective of the award is to promote mobility among European chemical engineering students. The award is presented every two years to the best European students of chemical engineering who have spent one or more semesters studying abroad.

The **EFCE Student Mobility Award 2009** will consist of three prizes: 1st Prize: € 2,000; 2nd Prize: € 1,500; 3rd Prize: € 1,000.

The prizes will be awarded during the 8th World Congress of Chemical Engineering which will be held in Montréal, Quebec, Canada, from 23 to 27 August 2009. The prize-winners will be invited to attend the congress free of charge. Travel and accommodation expenses will be borne by EFCE after consultation and approval of the Frankfurt office of the EFCE General Secretariat.

All students who are citizens of a European country in which EFCE is represented can apply for the EFCE Student Mobility Award if they have successfully studied for at least one semester ( $\geq 30$  ECTU) in first or second cycle study programmes in chemical engineering in each of two or more different countries.

Applications should include the application form, which can be downloaded from the EFCE website ([http://www.efce.info/Student\\_Mobility\\_Award.html](http://www.efce.info/Student_Mobility_Award.html)), and the following attachments: curriculum vitae, transcript of records or similar documents of *all* places of study, other proof of academic performance (letter of support by academic supervisor, etc.), and a one-page essay about the experience of studying in different countries.

All documents should be submitted in *English* no later than 2 years after graduation.

The deadline for submission of applications is **31 January 2009**.
